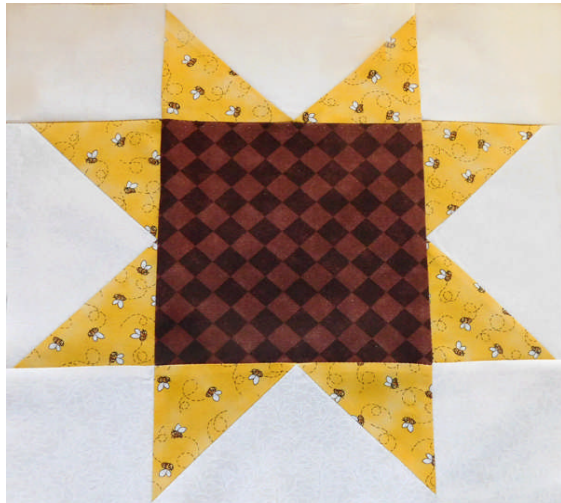
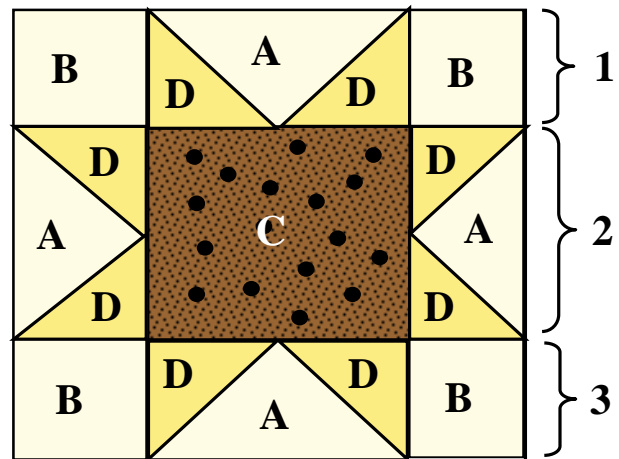

AUTUMN SUNFLOWER



YOU WILL NEED:

- 4 cream print 3.5" x 6.5" rectangles (A)
- 4 cream print 3.5" squares (B)
- 1 brown print 6.5" square (C)
- 8 gold or yellow 3.5" squares (D)

CONSTRUCTION:

Draw a diagonal line on each yellow square (D). With right sides together (RST) place a yellow square on a 3.5" x 6.5" rectangle matching 2 corners, and with diagonal line going from one corner to the center of cream rectangle. Stitch along diagonal. Flip yellow fabric to outside and press, then cut extra fabric underneath the corner triangle away at 1/4". Press again. Do this to the other corner of this rectangle. You will have a large flying goose. Now do the same to the other 3 rectangles. Be sure to press often. When that is done, sew a cream square to both outside ends of two geese to build two B-DAD-B units. Set aside. Now sew the remaining two geese to each opposite sides of the 6.5" rectangle along the long edges to build a single DAD-C-DAD unit. Join the three units together as shown in the upper right. Press being careful not to stretch all the bias edges, then starch well. Block should be 12-1/2" square.
