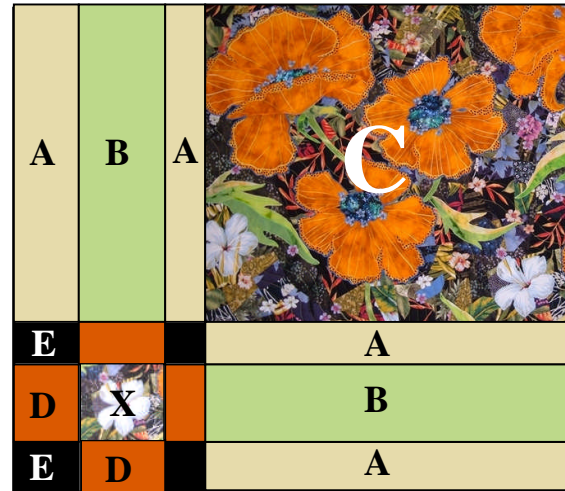


**JUNE, 2018**

**TREASURED HEIRLOOM**



This block should be made from a large floral print of deep rich colors that give the feeling of an heirloom project. The **B** strips should compliment the **C** square colors; the **A** strips of deep tan or caramel print; the small **D** rectangles should be a print that is of a color found in the large **C** square. The small **X** square should be made from a "feature" in the **C** fabric (like a little flower.) The four **E** squares must be solid black.

**WHAT YOU WILL NEED:**

Large rich floral print

1 8-1/2" square (C)

1 2-1/2" square (X)

Tan or caramel print

4 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles (A)

Complimentary color to the C print

2 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles (B)

Solid Black

4 1-1/2" squares (E)

A color used in block C

4 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles (D)

**CONSTRUCTION:**

Sew the top A-B-A-C unit. Press and starch.

Construct two E-D-E units and one

D-X-D unit. Construct the bottom A-B-A

unit. Sew the D-X-D unit between the two E-

D-E units. Press seams well. Then attach the

bottom A-B-A unit to the right of the previous

unit. Join the top unit to the bottom unit,

carefully matching all seams. Press the entire

block and starch well. The block should

measure **12-1/2"** square.
