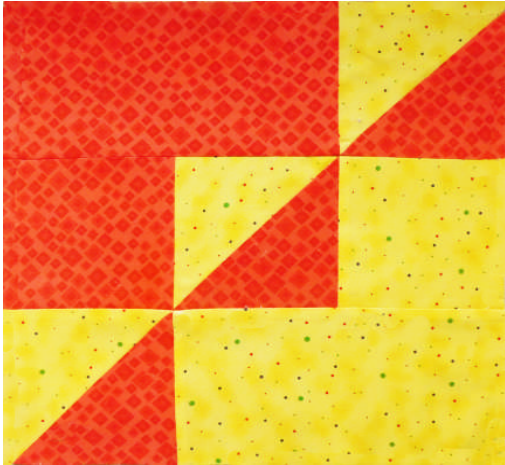
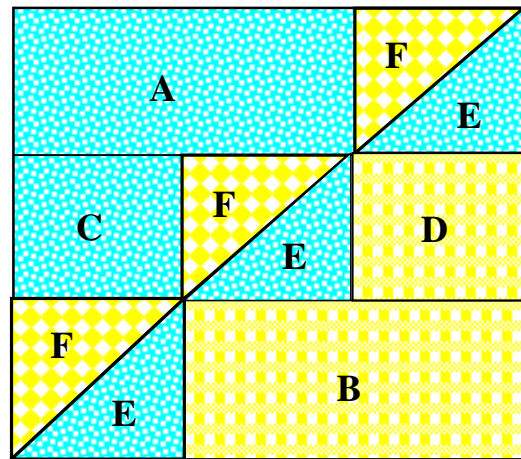


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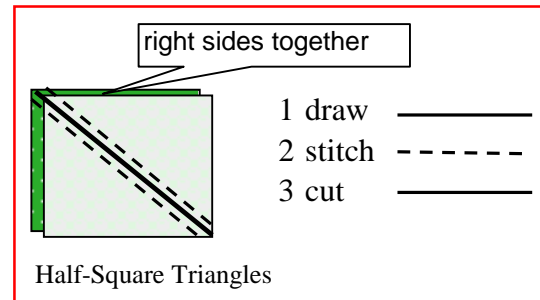
BACK TO SCHOOL



A block inspired by the kiddy crayons of yesteryear.

YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 4.5' x 8.5" rectangle of any primary or wild color **very small** print (A)
- 1 4.5' x 8.5" rectangle of a primary **yellow** color **very small** print (B)
- 1 4.5" square of color A (C)
- 1 4.5" square of color B (D)
- 2 4-7/8" squares of color A (E)
- 1 4-7/8" squares of color B (F)



CONSTRUCTION: Construct half-square triangles with the 4-7/8" squares as shown in the diagram above. After sewing and cutting, press open and starch them well and set 3 aside. Sew top row A-FE blocks together. Sew middle row C-FE-D blocks together. Sew bottom row FE-B blocks together. Now just join rows 1, 2 and 3 as shown above. Press and starch the unit well. If puckers occur in the corners of triangles, try reversing the direction of the seam allowances on the back and repress. This block should measure 12-1/2 inches.
