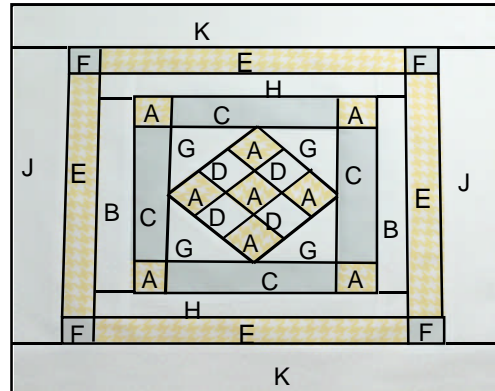
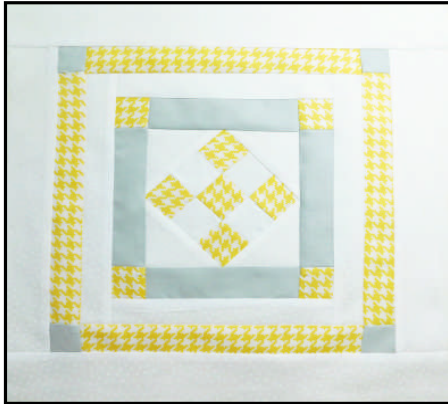


## APRIL 2019 Five of Diamonds



### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Use one pastel color, a very pale grey, and white. Cut as follows:

From the pastel fabric:

- 9 1-1/2" squares (A)
- 4 1-3/8" x 8-1/2" rectangles (E)

From pale grey fabric:

- 4 1-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles (C)
- 4 1-3/8" squares (F)

From WHITE tone-on-tone cut:

- 4 1-1/2" squares (D)
- 2 3" squares cut diagonally (G)
- 2 1-3/8" x 6-3/4" rectangles (B)
- 2 1-3/8" x 8-1/2" rectangles (H)
- 2 1-5/8" x 10-1/4" rectangles (J)
- 2 1-5/8" x 12-1/2" rectangles (K)

Always press and starch your pieces.

### CONSTRUCTION

Sew a 9-patch with 5 (A) and 4 (D) squares. Sew a (G) to opposing sides and press and trim. Sew a (G) to the other opposing sides. Press and trim.

Sew a (C) to the left and right sides of the center unit. Sew an (A) block to each end of the two remaining (C) pieces. Sew an (A/C) piece to the top and bottom. Sew a (B) piece to the left and right sides of the Unit, then an (H) piece to the top and bottom. (You are building a log cabin.)

Sew an (E) piece to the left and right sides of the previous unit. Sew an (F) to each end of two (E) pieces. Sew an (E/F) piece to the top and bottom.

Sew a (J) piece to the left and right sides and then a (K) piece to the top and bottom. Press and starch the finished **12-1/2"** block.
