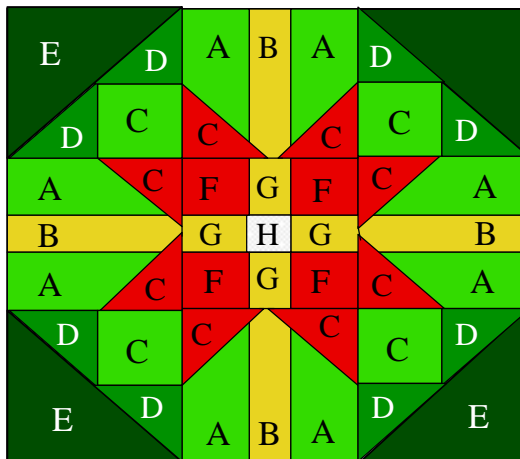


# OCTOBER 2017 - December Bloom



## YOU WILL NEED:

Small prints of six fabrics.

From white on white cut:

1 1.5" square (H)

From bright red cut:

4 2" squares (F)


8 2-1/2" squares (C)

From bright green cut:


4 2-1/2" squares (C)

8 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (A)

From medium green cut:

4 2-7/8" squares (D) 

From dark green cut:

1 4-7/8" squares (E) 

From gold cut"

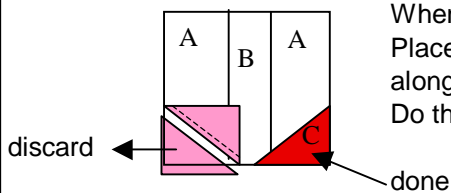
4 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (B)

4 1-1/2" x 2" rectangles (G)

## How to build the finished block:

- 1 Build 2 F-G-F units
- 2 Build 1 G-H-G unit
- 3 Join the above to make the center 9-patch
- 4 Build 4 A-B-A units. Add C to these.
- 5 Sew short edge of D to bright green C. Press open. Sew another D to a C. Press. Make 4 of these units.
- 5 Sew D-C-D units to E. Press.
- 6 Construct top (EDC-ABAC-EDC) then middle (ABAC, 9-patch, ABAC) then bottom like the top.
- 7 Join the three rows together matching seams carefully.
- 9 Press to 12-1/2" total and starch.

## A-B-A unit construction:



When the 3-piece unit is done, draw diagonal line on 4 red Cs. Place C on bottom corner of unit with right sides together. Sew along diagonal. Flip sewn triangle over, press, cut away surplus. Do that to both bottom corners of the 4 A-B-A units.
