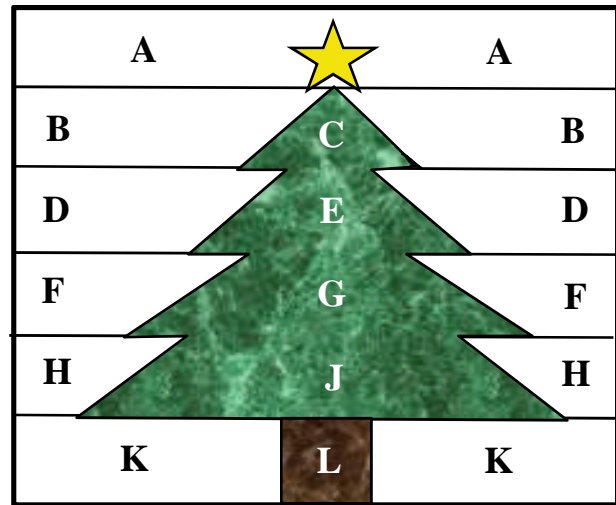

O Tannenbaum



You will need a white-on-white print, a green print for the tree, a brown print for the trunk, a gold or yellow for a star applique, or a jewel or tree-topper embellishment for the top of the tree. You can "trim" the tree in any fashion you want, or just leave it plain.

From white print:

- 1 12.5" x 2.5" rectangle
- 2 6.5" x 2.5" rectangle
- 4 5.5" x 2.5" rectangle
- 2 4.5" x 2.5" rectangle
- 2 3.5" x 2.5" rectangle

From green tree print:

- 1 4.5" x 2.5" rectangle
- 1 6.5" x 2.5" rectangle
- 1 8.5" x 2.5" rectangle
- 1 10.5" x 2.5" rectangle

From brown print:

- 1 2.5" x 2.5" square

From gold or yellow print

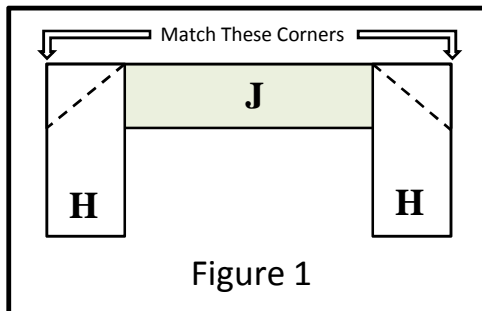
- 1 3" squares

**Construction:**

See Fig. 1: Place 'J' strip right-side-up on table. Place 2 'H' strips on top of each end of 'J' with right sides together, being sure to match top outer corners (arrows) as shown. Draw a line from inner top corners of 'H' to outer bottom corners of 'J'. Pin pieces together. Sew the drawn line. Open out the pieces and press toward the white. Trim excess fabric on back. Do the same with G-F and E-D pairs.

For the C-B pairs, complete the left side first, open the 2 pieces out and press toward the white. Trim the excess fabric. Now place the right hand "B" strip in place on the corner and draw the line as before. It will look like you are going too far and not meeting the proper place on the green fabric. You are OK. This second seam will overlap the first seam in the middle by 1/4". Sew, open and press.

Sew the K-L-K strip with straight seams for the tree trunk. Layout all the sewn strips in order of size to form the tree. Sew the strips together to finish the 12-1/2" block. Press and starch.



Cut this star from the gold fabric and raw-edge applique it above the tree. Trim the tree as desired. On not.
