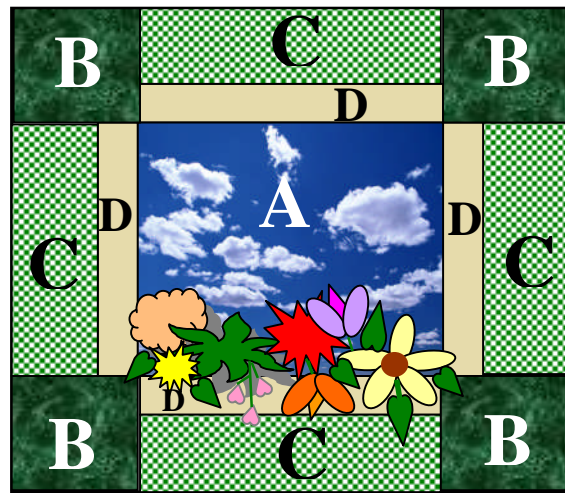

Mom's Window Garden



You will need a fabric that looks like a cloudy sky. Many landscape fabrics are available in this design. Or, you could paint a blue fabric with white clouds. You will also need a deep cream print, dark green print and light green print. All prints should be very small patterns.

You should cut:

- 1 6-1/2" square blue sky with clouds print (A)
- 4 3-1/2" squares dark green print (B)
- 4 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles light green (C)
- 4 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles dark cream (D)
- Lots bright color solid or small print scraps OR make ribbon or fabric flowers. Be sure to have some solid dark green for leaves.

Construction:

Sew all Cs to Ds along the long edge. Build Rows 1 and 3 (B-CD-B). Build Row 2 (C-D-A-D-C). Sew Row 1 to Row 2, add Row 3.

Now use your scraps in jagged shapes, or cut flower petal shapes. Fuse these shapes with edges overlapping to get that garden look. Intersperse dark green for

the leaves. You can either thread-paint the scraps in place, or raw-edge applique each petal and flower in place. Or you can use purchased or hand-made ribbon or fabric flowers. Or you could embroider flowers in place. This part is where you use your own creativity and each block will look completely different. ANYTHING GOES with creating this block. Be sure to press and STARCH the block well. It should measure 12-1/2" when finished.
