



▶▶▶▶▶ Material Requirements:

72" x 78" cover quilt

- 2 jelly rolls or 78 - 2 ½" x WOF strips
- 4 ½ yards backing fabric
- ¾ yard binding fabric

48" x 54" quilt

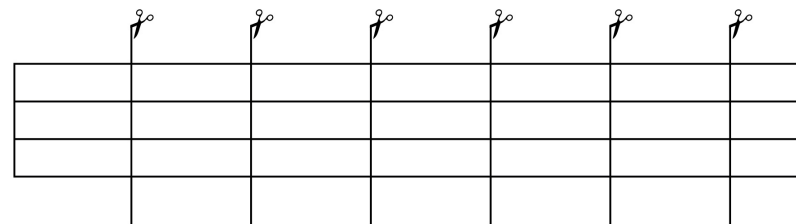
- 1 jelly roll or 36 - 2 ½" x WOF strips
- 3 yards backing fabric
- 1/2 yard binding fabric

▶▶▶▶▶ Before you begin:

1. Please read through all of the instructions.
2. All seam allowances are ¼".
3. WOF means width of fabric.
4. RST means right sides together.

▶▶▶▶▶ Block Assembly:

1. Select three jelly roll strips and sew together to create one 6 ½" x WOF rectangle. Press the seams open.
2. Using your rotary cutter, trim off one selvage end to square up your pieced rectangle and then cut into 6 ½" segments as shown. You will create a total of six 6 ½" blocks from each pieced rectangle.

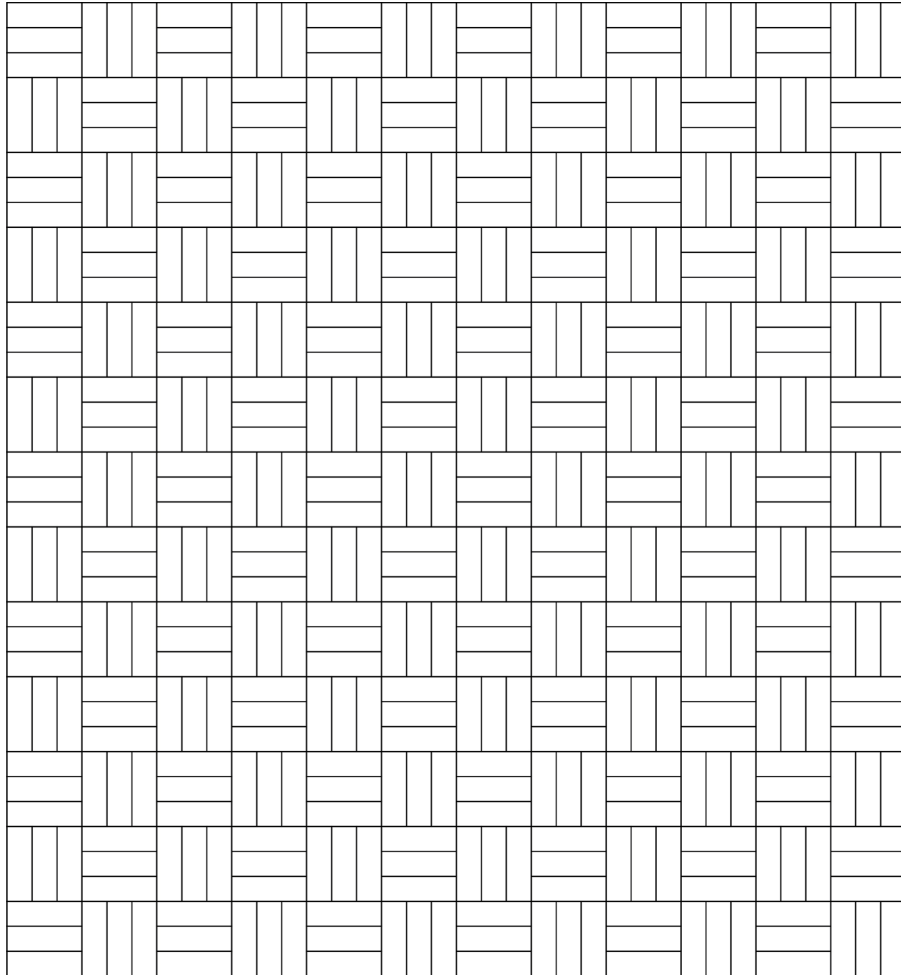


3. Repeat to create a total of 156 blocks for the 72" x 78" quilt or 72 blocks for the 48" x 54" quilt.

▶▶▶▶▶ Quilt Top Assembly:

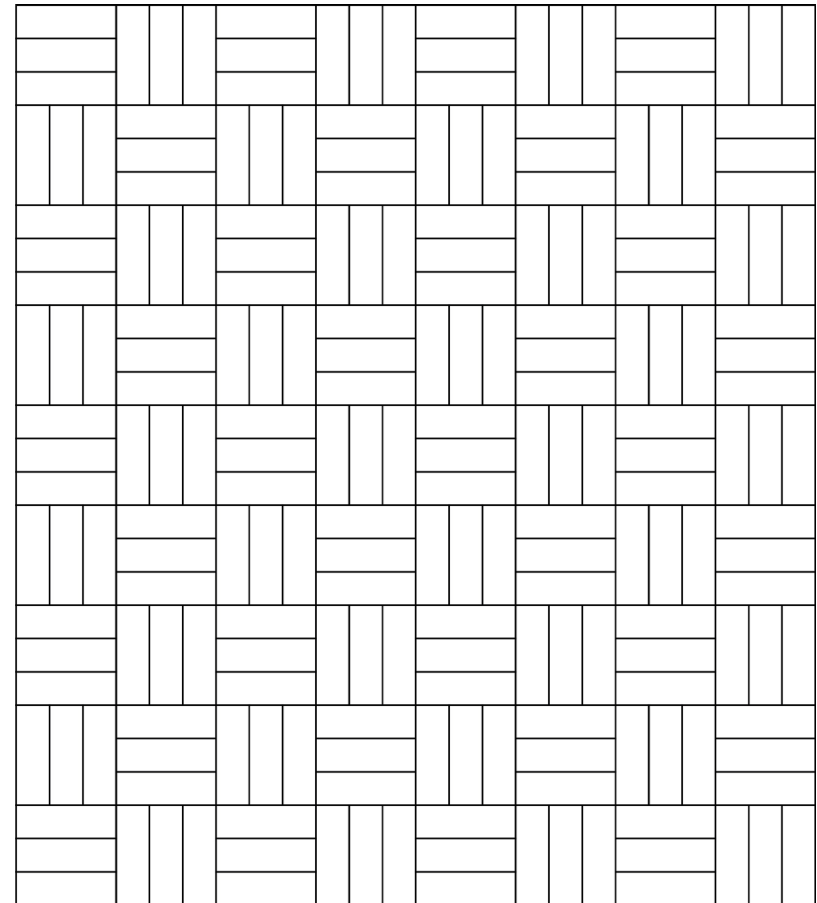
72" x 78" cover quilt

1. Lay out your 156 blocks into 13 rows of 12 blocks each (alternate the direction of the blocks as shown - vertical, horizontal, vertical, horizontal, etc.).



48" x 54" quilt

1. Lay out your 78 blocks into 9 rows of 8 blocks each (alternate the direction of the blocks as shown - vertical, horizontal, vertical, horizontal, etc.).



▶▶▶▶▶ Finish the Quilt:

1. Make a quilt sandwich with the quilt top, batting and backing and baste.
2. Machine or hand quilt as desired.
3. Bind using 2 1/2" x WOF strips of fabric stitched end to end.
